It was noted that the Clyde Theatre Renovation is outsourcing legal counsel to Beckman Lawson due to conflict of interest for Carson Boxberger and therefore legal fees are higher than anticipated. Most projects are complete or near completion.

Other Business Mike Galbraith

The Board Members reviewed the status update of the RCI Fund Deposits presented by Erin Whittle. Erin noted that a considerable amount of funds has yet to be dispersed from the IEDC. The IEDC has been waiting for conditions to be met before they disburse the funds, yet they offer conditional approvals.

The Board Members then reviewed the 2017 NEI RDA operating budget. Cash flow is good and there may be opportunity to utilize the accruing interest.
